

PAMA Art Exhibition Terms and Conditions

You must read, agree and accept all the terms and conditions contained on this registration between YOU (the Participating Artist) and the Philippine Australian Multicultural Association (PAMA) Inc. Please note that your paintings are referred to as “artwork”. PAMA and The ARTIST agree on the following Terms and Conditions.

1. ARTIST ELIGIBILITY

Apart from invited international artists, this exhibition encourages local Australian artists to showcase their artworks. PAMA also aims to provide opportunities for novice and emerging artists (especially within the local Ipswich community) to build their art career.

The Artist must have a full and complete ownership of the artwork they are presenting to PAMA Inc. The Artist must not provide false information of any kind that relates to their artworks. Any breach of this, PAMA has the right to immediately withdraw the artwork or artist from the exhibition and media campaign.

2. APPROVAL OF ARTIST and ARTWORKS

PAMA has the right to make the final decision to select the Artists and artwork pieces for display throughout the exhibition.

3. ARTWORKS FOR EXHIBIT

The following are the details that Artists must consider for preparation:

- a. Artists are encouraged to present at least one (1) and a maximum of three (3) artworks. The Artist must also ensure that their Art is secured for hanging. We require a wire or “D” ring hanging system at the back of their paintings.
- b. Each Artwork must have maximum weight of 15kg for each artwork for safety.
- c. Artworks must be dropped off Monday (31 October) at the drop off location in Redbank Plains. Drop off hours will be between 9am – 6 pm. Please call Marissa (0402129298) to confirm the drop off location or make other arrangements.
- d. PAMA Art Exhibit will be on 4 Nov-7 Nov 2022 at Ipswich Community Gallery (D’Arcy Doyle Place, Ipswich QLD 4305).
- e. The Artist, their family and friends are fully encouraged to attend the PAMA Art Exhibit Gala Night Opening on 4 November 2022 from 6pm.
- f. While PAMA will treat each artwork with care, we advise the Artists to have their own artwork insurance policy.

The Artist must be able to provide and sign a COA (Certificate of Authenticity) upon request by the buyer. PAMA reserves the right to select for display and categorise the artworks presented to them.

4. MEDIA CONSENT

Upon registration to the exhibit, Artists have agreed to have artworks filmed or photographed for PAMA Art Exhibition campaign and displayed in any social media platform, newspaper, radio, TV and magazines.

5. PRICING and COMMISSION

The Artist is given the freedom to set the price of their artworks and agree for PAMA to receive 20% of the total retail price for all artworks sold. Please note that PAMA is a non-profit organisation therefore, the proceeds will be used for future projects which promote harmony, unity, and growth within the community.

6. PAYMENT TO ARTIST

Payment to the Artist for the sale of their artwork (exclusive of the 20% commission for PAMA), will be made within 8 business days. It is the responsibility of the Artist for paying tax that is due to the sales of their artwork. A 7-day customer return policy will be given provided that the artwork is returned by the buyer to the Artist in its original condition.

7. COPYRIGHT

It is the responsibility of the Artist to ensure that the artworks submitted to PAMA for the exhibit does not infringe any copyright or intellectual property rights on any third parties.

8. LIABILITY

PAMA will not be liable for any loss or damages of the artworks prior, during and after the Art Exhibit. PAMA bears no responsibility in handling art works, insurance of art works entered is entrant's responsibility.

9. AWARDS

There will be two awards for this exhibit:

- i) The PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD will be based on the number of public votes. The artwork with the highest number of votes will be the winner and will be announced on the 8 November 2022.
- ii) The ARTIST SELECTION AWARD will be determined by a professional artist who will make the final selection.

10. ARTWORK RETURNS

It is the responsibility of the Artist to pick up their unsold artworks on 8 November from 11am to 3pm at the exhibit venue. Unclaimed artworks will become the property of the PAMA after 30 days and will be up for sale on the PAMA website.
